HISTORY IN THE MAKING, PITCH BY PITCH

Legend's Baseball was founded in 2009 when David Klein, an undrafted catcher, wrapped up his academic obligations with UCSB, secured his degree, and retired from his role as a Gaucho backstop. With laser-like focus, David set out to create his own collegiate summer team and cutting edge, youth baseball camp.

EARLY DAYS

The Menlo Park Legends collegiate team played their first games at Menlo-Atherton High School and headquartered the first 3-week youth baseball camp at Red Morton Community Center. With camps now scattered throughout the Bay area, Legends Baseball has certainly grown by leaps and bounds!

The inaugural season included a 30-game schedule and, as word of the team grew, more talented players found their way onto the Legend's roster. Soon, the competition included some of the toughest teams in the state battling the Legends through exciting 45-50 game schedules that ran from early June and ending in late July.

In 2012, the Menlo Park Legends were added to the California Collegiate League, widely acknowledged as the most competitive league in California, if not on the entire West Coast.

The Legends quickly gained notoriety as a consistently formidable foe, with a roster packed with game changers, and hard-nosed players. The Legend's friendly home field confines include(ed) Menlo College, Canada College, Menlo-Atherton HS and Baylands Field in Palo Alto.

LEGACY OF GREATNESS

From 2009 until 2016, the Legends have had players drafted 8 years in a row. All in all, that's 50 players playing pro ball that have been touched by the program. This elite group includes 3 Olympians (Alon Leichman, and DJ Sharabi), as well as 3 Major Leaguers (Tyler Ivy, Zac Grotz, and Mark Mathias).

LEGACY TO BE WRITTEN

After a 5 year hiatus, the Legends brought collegiate baseball to the Peninsula once again in 2022, making the playoffs in their first two years back. If you are an aspiring young collegiate ballplayer looking to write your own legacy in the summer of '25, to develop your skills, get that 4 year college or pro deal of your dreams, and/or prepare yourself for the big battles of Fall, we invite you to become legendary with us.

Legends Youth Summer Camp Coaching

All players will be encouraged to work at least 2 weeks at Legends Youth Summer Camps during the day and will be paid a starting rate of \$20/hour – approximately \$600+/week.

California Collegiate League

The California Collegiate League (CCL), founded in 1993, has grown into the premier summer baseball league on the West Coast, consistently ranked among the top 10 collegiate leagues in the country.

With a rich history of developing future professional players, the league has become a cornerstone of summer baseball, featuring a 40-game season and the nationally televised North vs. South All-Star Game on Bally Sports West.

The CCL has seen significant growth, now stretching from Northern to Southern California, and continues to be a launchpad for MLB talent. Known for its competitive environment and high-caliber teams, the CCL offers players an elite stage to showcase their skills.

NICK SANZERI: HEAD COACH

Nick Sanzeri joined the Menlo Park Legends as the 4th head coach for Legends starting in the 2025 season, bringing over 13 years of coaching experience at the collegiate and professional levels. Known for his expertise in developing pitchers, Nick has trained over 75 NCAA Division I pitchers, 17 MLB draft picks, and worked with more than 20 MLB/MiLB players, including Tyson Ross and D.J. Snelten.

Nick began his coaching career at 21 as head coach at San Mateo High School. He later coached at Lamorinda Baseball Club and the College of San Mateo, where he helped lead the team to a CCCAA super-regional berth. From 2018 to 2023, he served as pitching coach at Mission College, where his innovative training methods propelled the team to two conference titles and multiple postseason appearances. Most recently, he was the pitching coach at Division I University of the Pacific, guiding the team to its best conference finish in over five years.

Nick holds a bachelor's degree from Notre Dame de Namur University and is TPI and Rapsodo certified. His vast experience and strong Bay Area ties make him the perfect fit to lead the Menlo Park Legends into the future.
